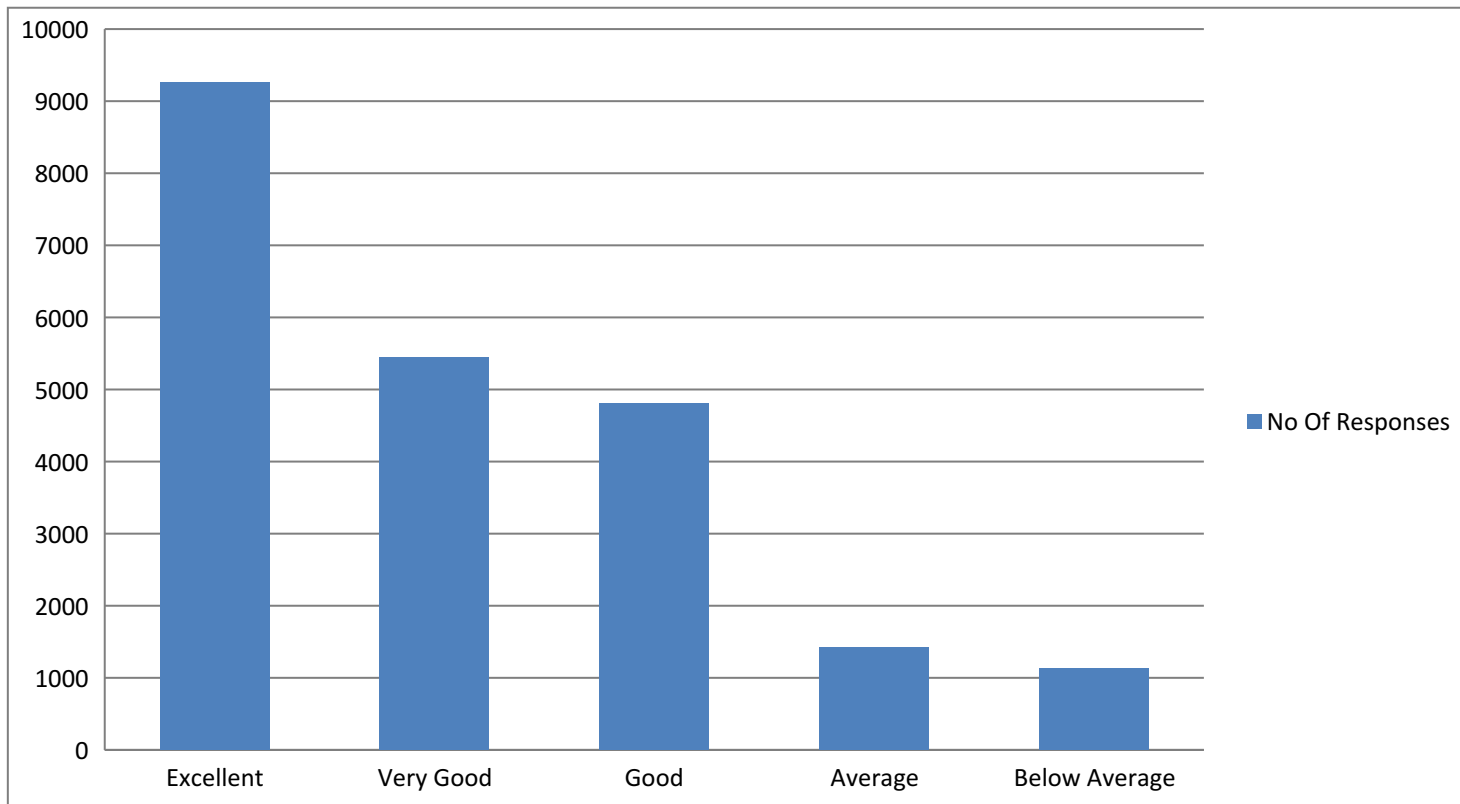

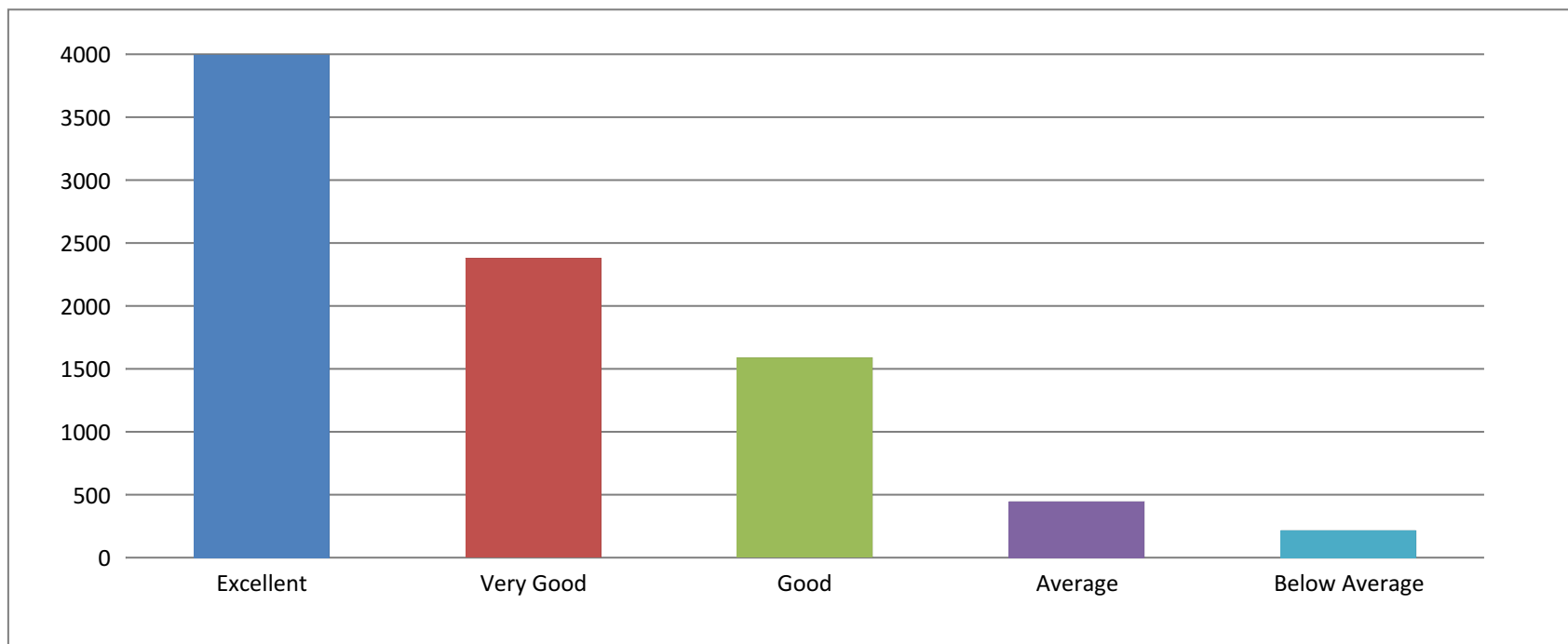

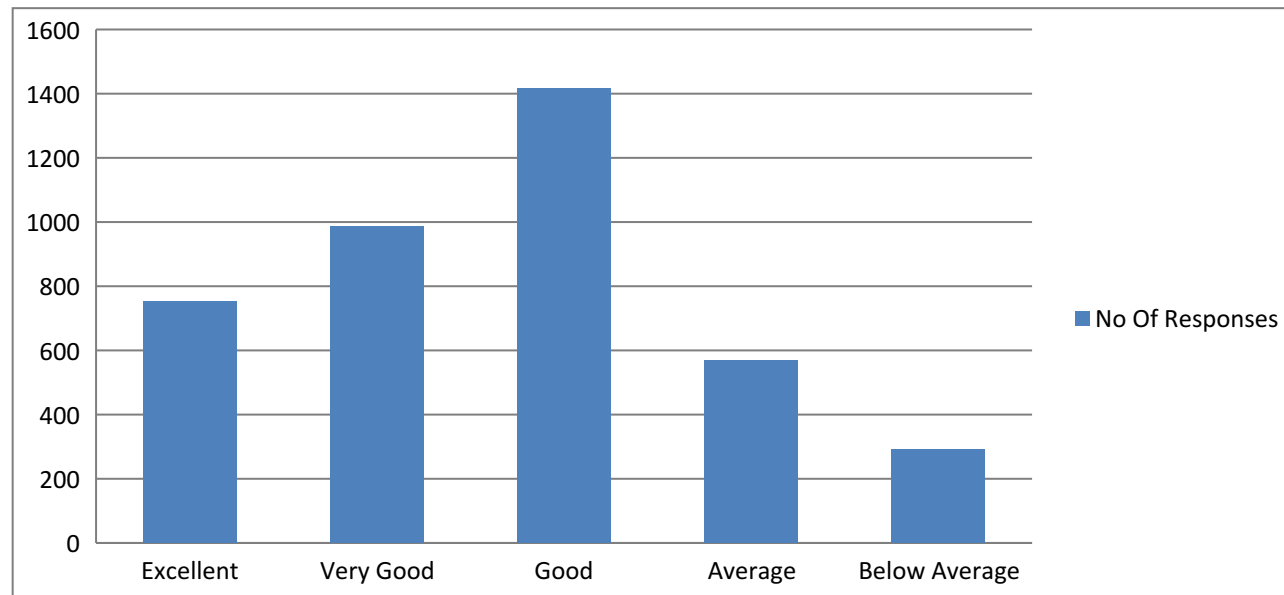

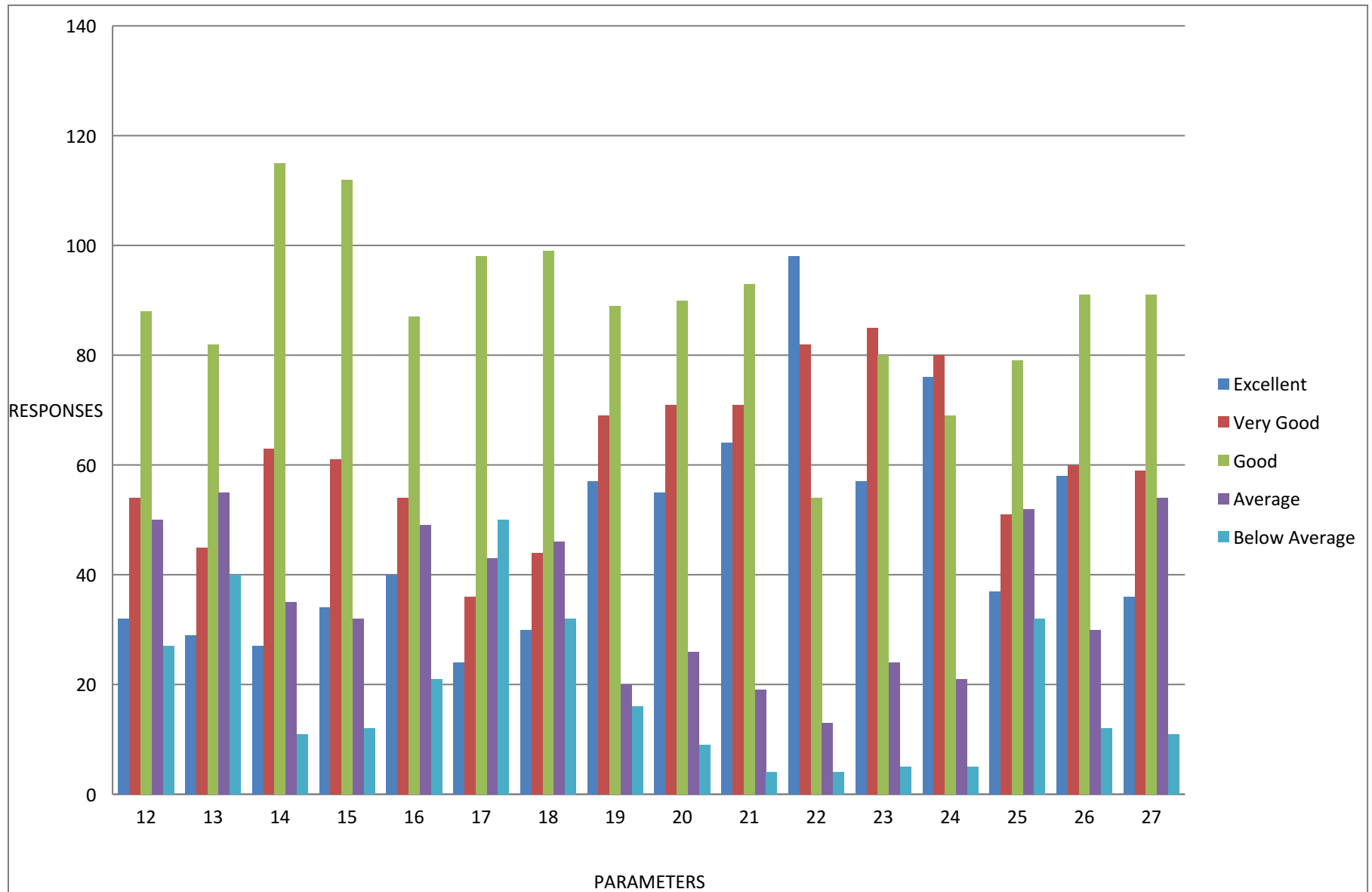
Grade wise student's responses on Infrastructure

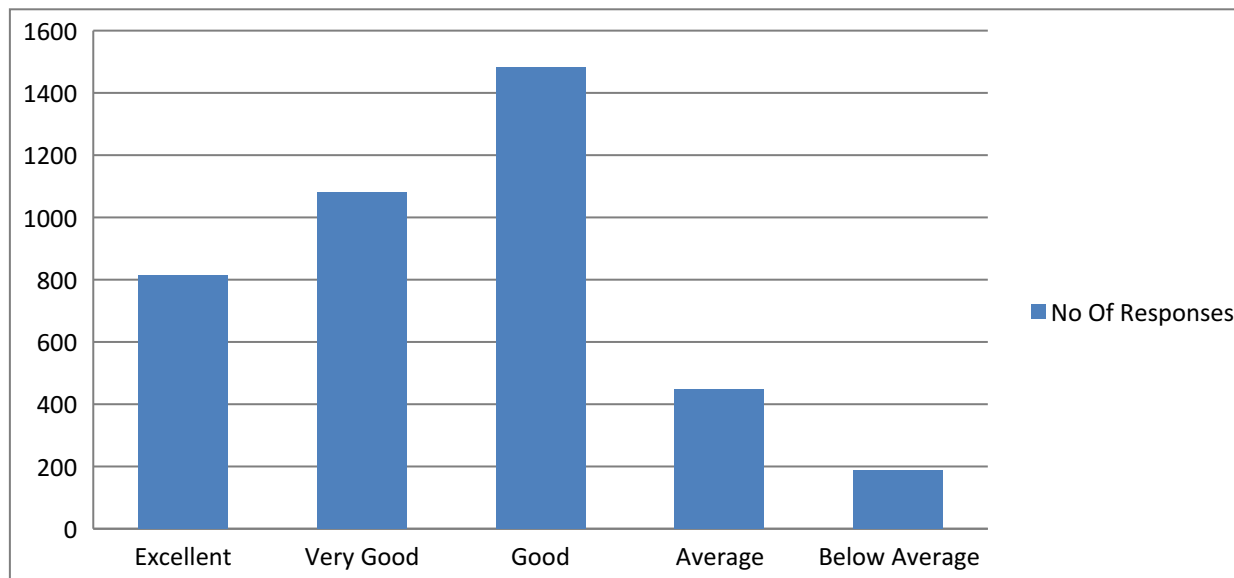

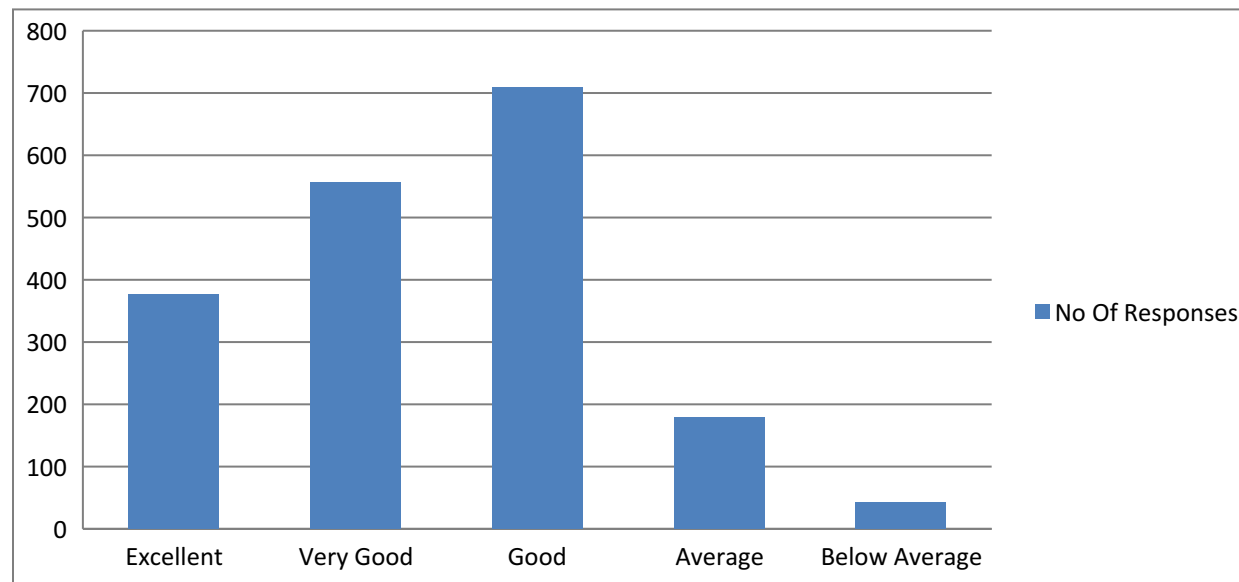

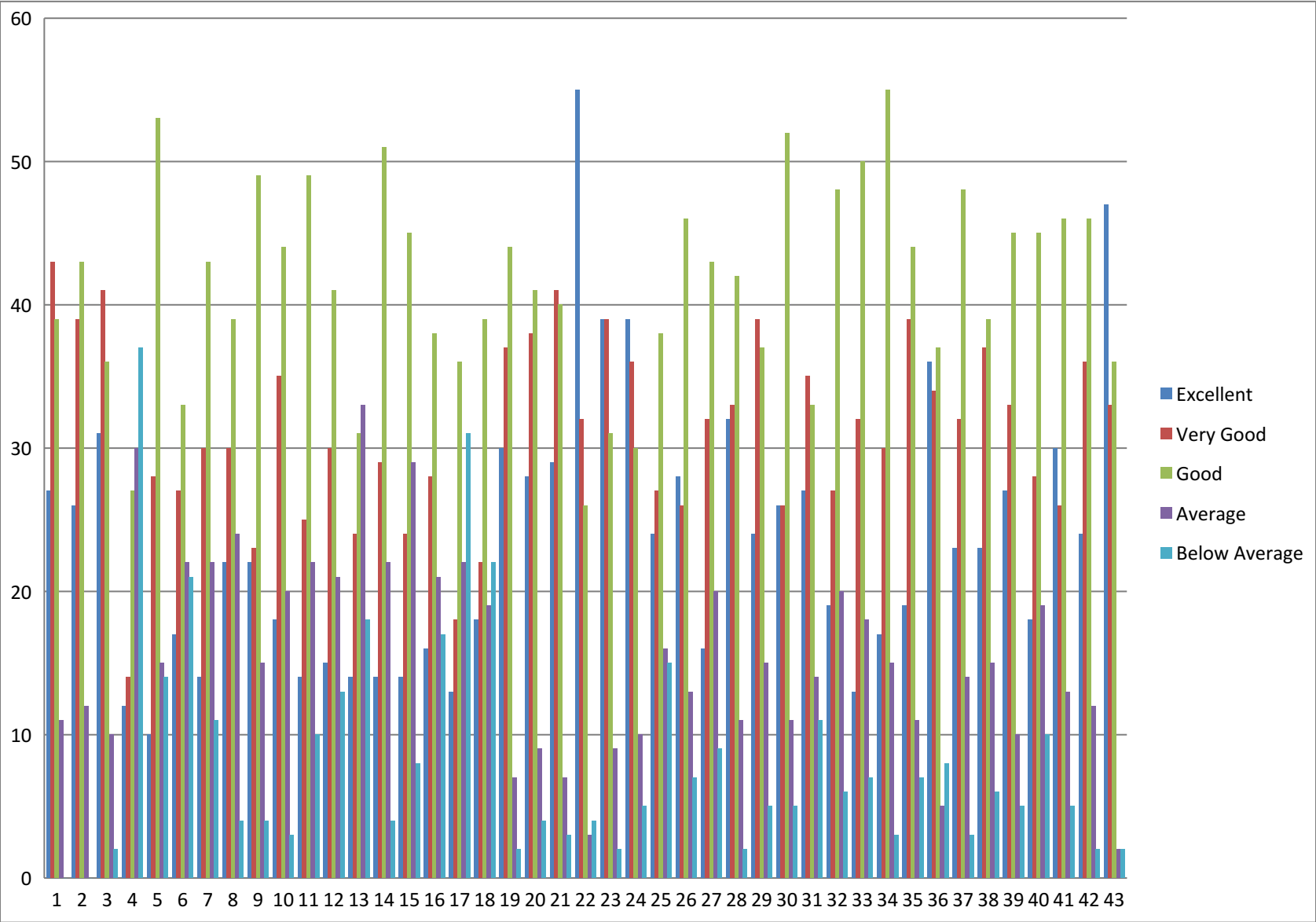

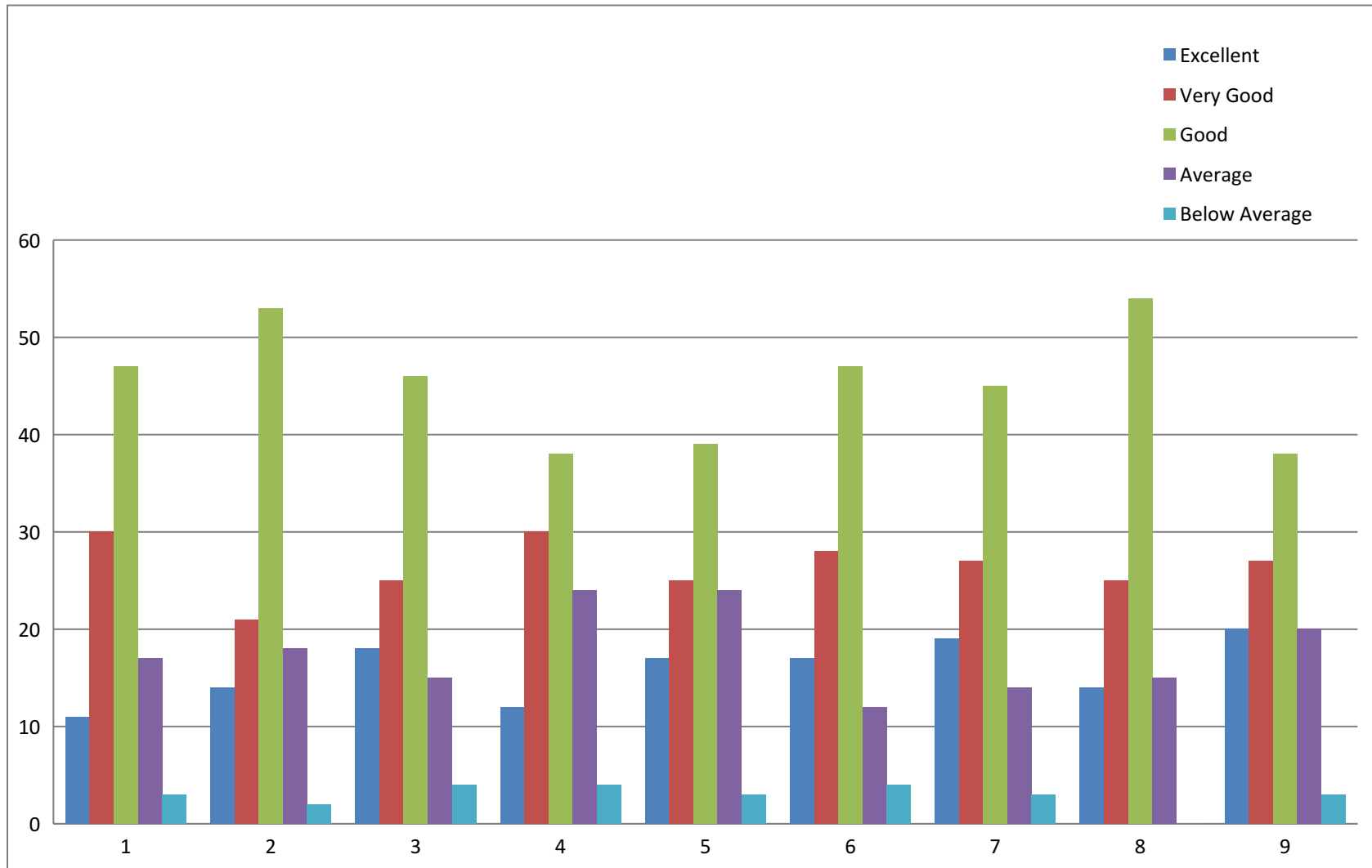

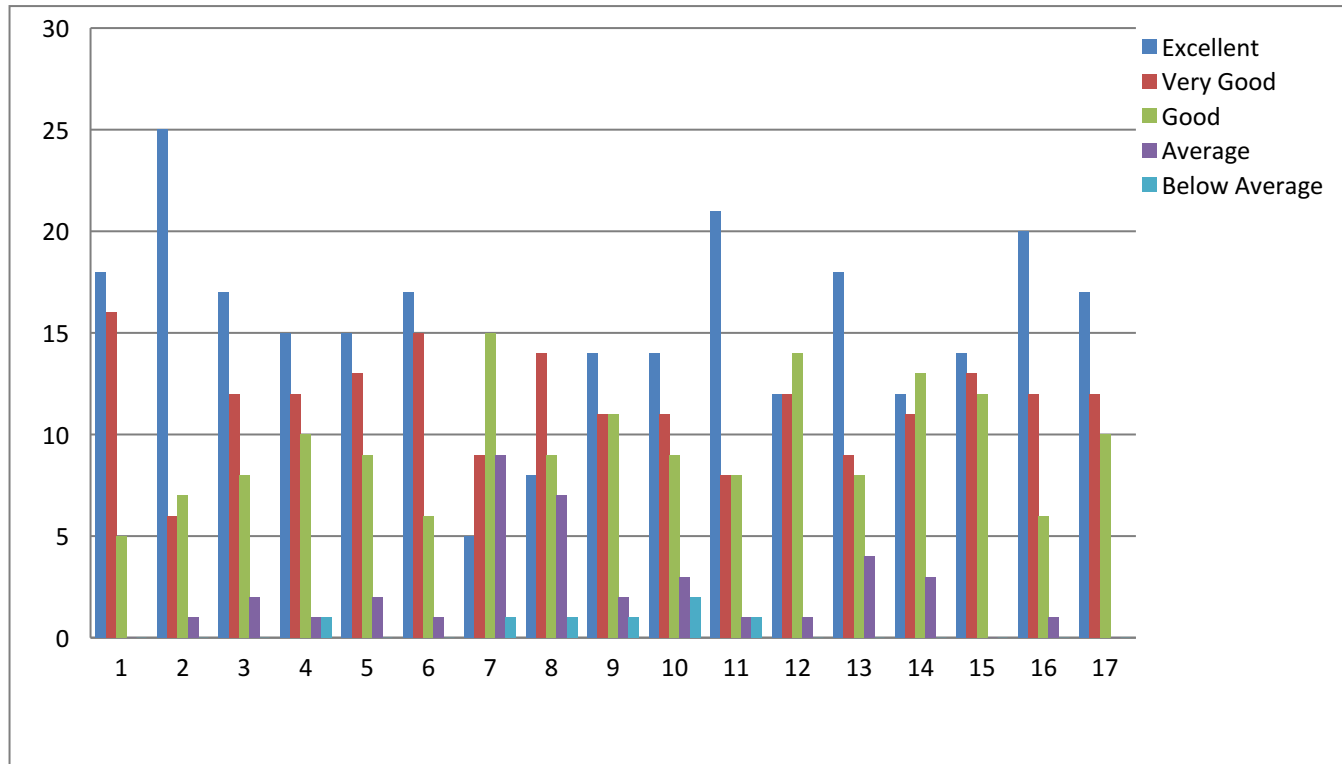

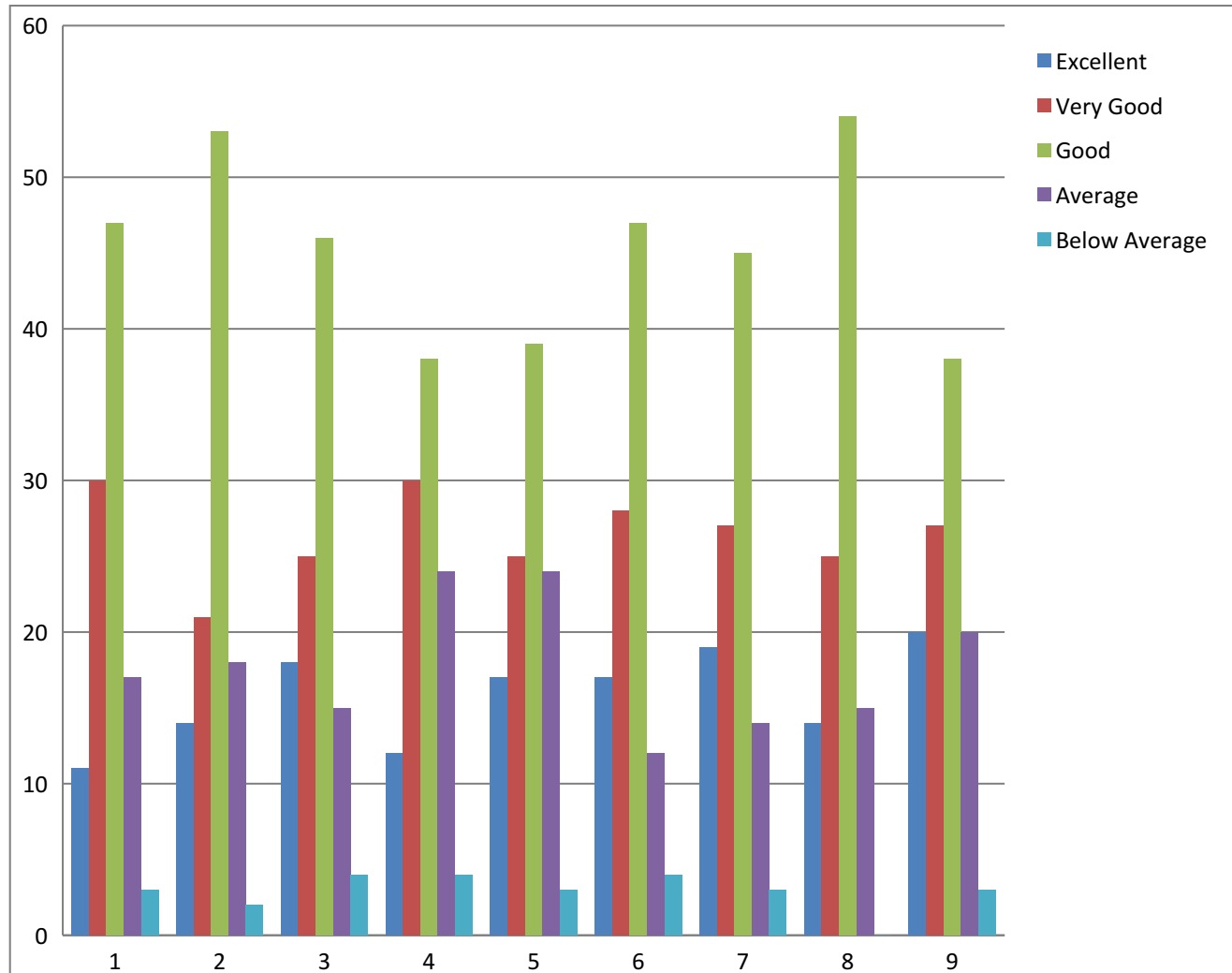

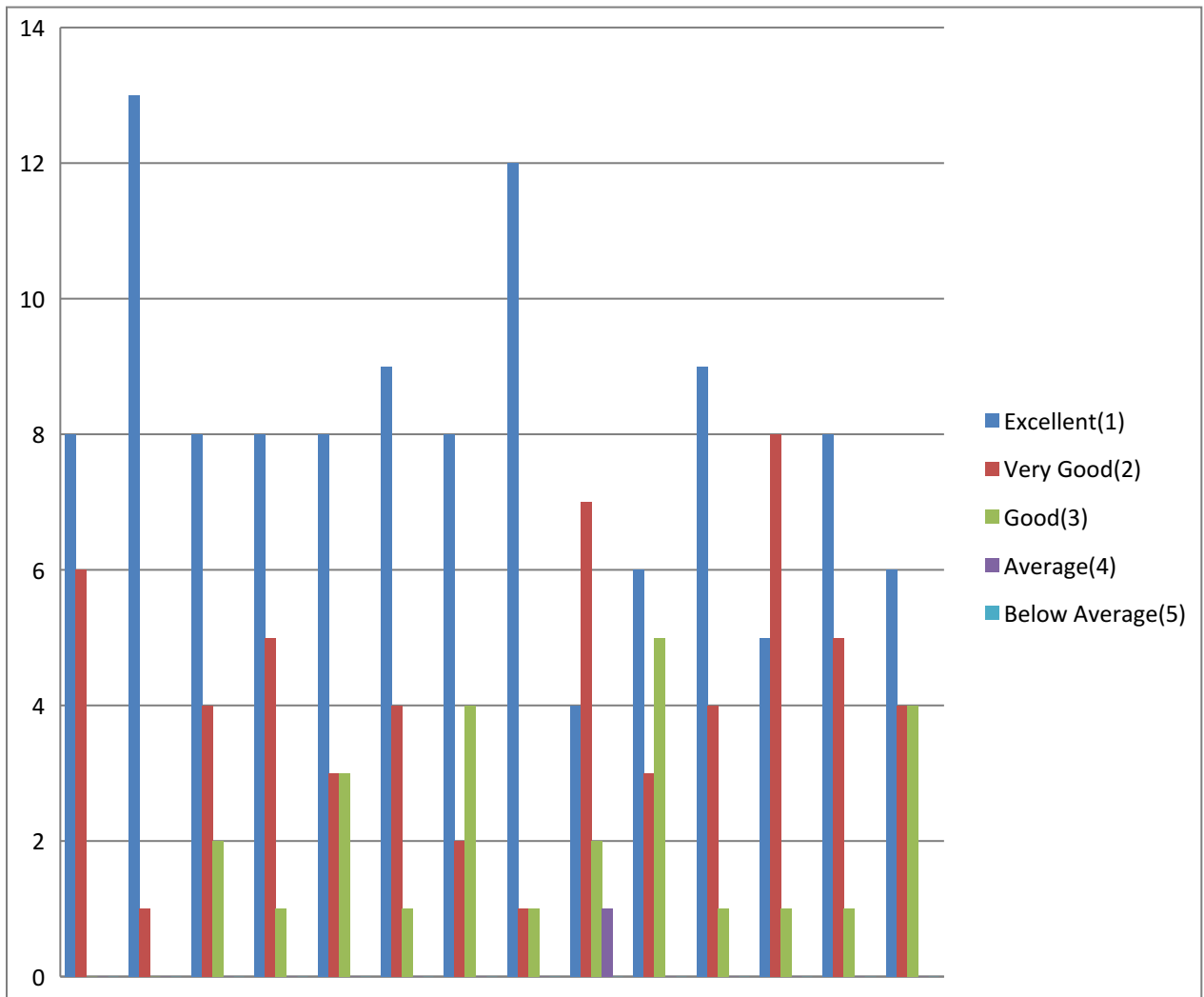
